




# EAGLES CLASS

#### **Activity One - This will be set on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September and will be due in on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September**

Our topic this term is the Anglo-Saxons. In order for us to learn about the Anglo-Saxons, we rely a lot on information that archaeologists have dug up. Imagine you are an archaeologist and that you have found one of the objects on the adjacent page. Write a detailed description including; what it looks like, who might have used it, what it could have been used for, as well as any extra information that you can think of.

Extension: Write a paragraph to describe how you felt when you dug up the object.

#### **Activity Two - This will be set on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October and will be due in on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> October.**

In class we will be writing letters to persuade the Anglo-Saxons to come to Britain. For your writing task at home, we would like you to write a letter to a large supermarket company to persuade them to no longer use plastic wrapping for their fruit and vegetables.

Or: Write a persuasive letter to us about something you feel strongly about.

#### **Activity Three - This will be set on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> October and will be due in on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November.**

Choose your favourite book and write either:

- A detailed character description (Things to think about include: who the character is, what they look like, what their personality is, what is their role within the story?)
- Or
- A book review suitable for another child to read (Things to think about include: the plot, characters, an exciting part of the story, a suitable blurb that could accompany the book)

Challenge: Write a sequel to the book that you have chosen.
