

#### **Activity One - This will be set on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> January and due in on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January.**

Perseverance.

Our value for this term is perseverance. We would like you to write your own definition of perseverance, explaining what it means to you in as much detail as possible.

We would then like you to recount a time when you demonstrated perseverance. You will need to explain when the event occurred, what you were trying to achieve, how you used perseverance and how you felt when you completed the task / event.

#### **Activity Two - This will be set on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> January and due in on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> February.**

In class, after Christmas, we will be looking at different types of poetry. We would like you to write a poem based on 'At the end of the school day' (This is a poem that we will be working on in class and a copy will be sent home for you to refer to). You should think about where your poem is going to be set (not in a school) and which characters could be involved. Think about the imagery that you are creating.

#### **Activity Three - This will be set on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> February and due in Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February.**

Our topic in Science for the first half of the Spring Term is 'A world of living things'. We would like you to choose an animal to research and produce a **detailed fact file** about that animal. Think about if they are a predator or not. Are they herbivores, omnivores or carnivores? What is their habitat like? Remember to use sub-headings and include as much detail as you can. Pictures and labelled diagrams can also be included.

Challenge: Can you include the food chain with your animal in?
