


French - Places in a town

1. Start by making your own flashcards. Either cut out the pictures below and match with the correct word or make your own!



2. Games to play with flashcards (your choice):

- What's missing? (2+ people)
 - Have some flash cards in a row (make sure you know what they are) and try to memorise the order. One person closes their eyes, the other person turns a card over. The first person then opens their eyes and says the missing card. If they get it right, they win a point. Try to say the words on the cards before each new round.
- Memory game (1+ person)
 - Have all the cards in a row (make sure you know what they are). Say the names of each card in order. When you get to the end of the row, turn the first card over and say all the names of the cards again (including the one you turned over). Then turn over the second card (keeping the first card turned over) and then say all the names of the cards again. See how far you can get! Can you remember all of the cards in order without seeing the pictures?
- Pairs (1+ person)
 - (for this you need a set of pictures and a set of words). Have all cards facing the floor in a grid. Turn two cards over and say the words on the cards. If the cards don't match, turn them back over and turn two more cards over. If the cards match, take the cards out of the grid.
- Splat (3+ people)
 - Have some cards in a row and two people competing against each other. The third person says the name of a card and the two players have to touch the correct card. The first person to get it right wins a point.

Extension: Draw your own town and label it with the words you have learned. Try to describe it.
