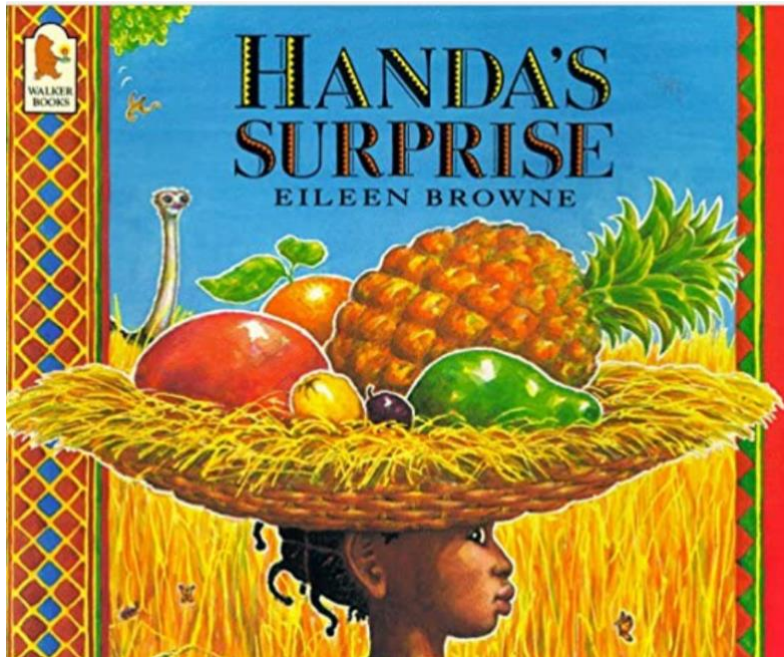

Be able to name five animals from the UK

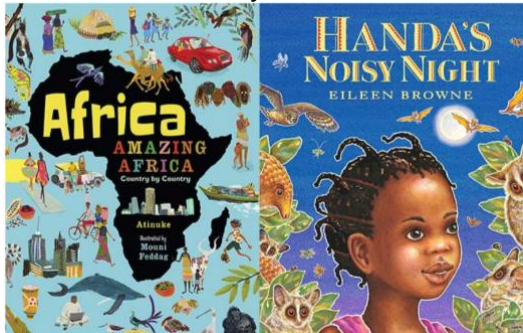
