<p><b>What is the name of the Jewish place of worship?</b> Synagogue</p>	<p><b>Why do Jews keep Shabbat?</b> Accept any answer that refers to God resting on the 7<sup>th</sup> day in the story of creation or God giving Moses the 10 commandments (observe the Sabbath)</p>
