Safe / safety - protected from or not exposed to danger or risk

Emergency - a serious, unexpected and often dangerous situation involving immediate action

Responsibility - having a duty to deal with something or having control over someone

Indoor - within a building or undercover

Outdoor - outside of a building, in the open air

Online - connected to a computer

Risk - a situation where you are exposed to danger

Hazard - a danger or a risk

Situation - a set of circumstances in which a person finds him or herself

Pedestrian - a person walking rather than travelling in a vehicle
