A Message from Mr Carlyle

It has certainly felt this week that we have experienced four seasons in one day and no doubt we will continue to see some extremes in the coming days and weeks. It would be very helpful if the children come to school prepared for the changes in weather; can we please ask that all coats, waterproofs, wellies etc are clearly named, to avoid any confusion.

I have had the opportunity this week to spend some time with children who have shown me their work. It is always a pleasure to see how hard they have been working and the pride they have taken in their achievements. There is a risk that we take for granted how diligent and resilient the children in our school are but I am sure that over the course of this term we will find the right ways to celebrate and enjoy their successes.

Many thanks for the feedback on the attendance information that I sent out the other week. It is important that it remains high on our agenda over the course of this term and beyond, as there are very clear links between consistent attendance and academic outcomes. Whilst being at school every day is key, so is ensuring that children arrive at school on time. Registers are taken by 8.50am and learning starts immediately afterwards. The Local Authority provide information with regards to punctuality and consistent lateness has a long term cumulative build-up. For example, if a pupil is 5 minutes late every day then over a year that equates to 3.4 days missed a year; if they are 10 minutes late this is 6.9 missed days and 15 minutes late equals 10.3 missed days per year. We of course realise and appreciate that things can crop up unexpectedly but clearly it is in the best interests of the children's learning that there are clear systems and routines to ensure punctuality at the start of the day.

A date for your diaries; our Harvest Festival Service will be held on Wednesday 18th October at 9am at Tacolneston Church. Further details will follow.


