Thank you for supporting all our fundraising events this year, we will share more about recent purchases in the New Year. The total money raised from our Christmas events will also be announced after Christmas.


We still have a few Christmas mugs and glasses left, they are £3 each. If you would like to purchase one please speak to Amy Harrington.
