This week I have seen some wonderful designing and making - Eagles busy working on their pop-up books which will tell the stories they have written in their English lessons, and Sparrowhawks building model Anderson Shelters as they think about the impact of WWII on families and children living in cities during the war.

School leadership and teaching staff have been working hard on curriculum development over recent weeks, and will continue this during our INSET day on Thursday next week. In the summer term we will be embarking on new teaching approaches in Geography and History. We will be building on education research and what children tell us about how they learn best - with hands-on approaches, discussions and activities that enable them to think hard about what they are learning. We will be focussing on securing core knowledge through regular and purposeful practise of skills and vocabulary whilst developing children's understanding and experience of what it means to be a geographer or historian. We look forward to these new approaches after Easter, and hope that children will be telling you all about their learning.

Our Easter service is just around the corner. Thank you for the arrangements you have been making to enable children to get to and from Tacolneston church with friends and family members. Being able to meet in the church will give a special sense of occasion to this time of celebration in the school calendar. We look forward to welcoming many of you to the Easter service as we conclude the Spring term.
