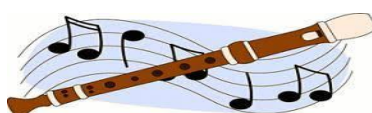
We may also be able to offer violin lessons if there is enough interest.

There is a charge for these lessons which will depend on whether the child has a 1-2-1 or small group lesson and how long the lessons are.

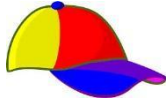
If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, this can be used to cover the cost of these lessons.

For parents / carers of children aged 9 and up

You are invited to attend two **free** online sessions to discuss all things "cyber".

You will also hear from Kent County Council's Education Safeguarding Team, who will provide an overview of;

- Some of the potential risks that children and young people may experience online.
- Advice to support parents to make informed decisions and keep their children safer online.
